RN will perform a variety of clinical tasks including, but not limited to, staffing infusion center, phone triage, scheduling forms and managing chronic needs of IBD patients.

Responsibilities

- Providing nursing care to gastroenterology patients
- Administer IV infusions, start IVs, draw blood. Monitor patient throughout infusion.
- Responsible for triaging patients, by phone or in person. The nurse appropriately incorporates the use of established protocols, available information, clinical judgement, and delegation to resolve the patient's issues.
- Assist the provider in managing chronic needs of IBD patients
- Review patients chart pre-procedure to ensure patient is scheduled at appropriate medical facility with appropriate level of sedation. Determines need for medical/cardiac clearance and medication holds; requests needed approvals from outside providers. Instruct patient on pre-procedure prep instructions and medication holds.
- Educate patients on their medical conditions and medications, including potential side effects, medication administration, etc.
- Ensures correct prescriptions by communicating with the healthcare provider and the pharmacy regarding new prescriptions, medication changes and refills.
- Differentiates normal from abnormal results and obtain recommendations from provider. Review results and recommendations with patient.
- Acts as a resource for medical assistants and non-clinical staff
- Documents patient care using EHR
